Deuteronomy 3:26"But the LORD was angry with me on your account, and would not listen to me; and the LORD said to me, 'Enough! Speak to Me no more of this matter."

This is a repented heart and not a rebellious heart that would like to hide 'pumpkin sized' sins under the sand and pretend that everything is normal. 3 "Thus says the LORD, 'This city will certainly be given into the hand of the army of the king of Babylon and he will capture it.'"

4 Then the officials said to the king, "Now let this man be put to death, inasmuch as he is discouraging the men of war who are left in this city and all the people, by speaking such words to them; for this man is not seeking the well-being of this people but rather their harm."

Jeremiah was beaten and thrown into a pit and prison for frightening the people with the truth, that's what is happening today also. We want encouragement, confidence, comfort and sugar-coated words but truth is taboo. Are you listening? Nobody wants to face the

truth as to why this world has been bombarded with a deadly plague!!! Preachers do not want to offend the people by saying, 'sins of the world has brought this upon the world, God is angry!' We got to tell the whole truth friend.
