Communion during this time!

Regarding communion, hand sanitizer will be available before you receive communion. There will be a dispenser on each side as you approach the chancel. You are urged to sanitize your hands before receiving the bread. The presiders will also be sanitizing their hands directly before touching the bread. The common cup will be replaced with the individual communion cups that will be held by one of the Eucharistic ministers. You will still receive the bread or the gluten-free wafer from a Eucharistic minister and will drink the juice from the individual cup rather than intinct the bread or wafer.

Should you choose not to partake of the communion elements, you are invited to come forward to receive a blessing. The signal to receive a blessing will be crossing your hands over your heart.
