Two weeks ago, Rabbi Rachel Timoner of Congregation Beth Elohim in Brooklyn, New York (where I am a member), performed her first virtual burial service. A member of her congregation had died at home of COVID-19, and because they were quarantined, his immediate family members — his wife and their two adult sons — were not able to travel to the cemetery. So Timoner went to the graveside and officiated the burial service by herself. The deceased's brother and sister-in-law were there, but 20 feet away, and the rest of the family watched over Zoom. "I was extremely moved that Rachel was willing to do this," the widow told me. "She kind of tried to make it like I was there. I think she knew that I was very troubled by
